Light Bar Instructions for 2014 Chevy1500

Hardware Kit Contains:

- 1) 5" x 1/2" Bolt
- 1) 1/2" Nylon Lock

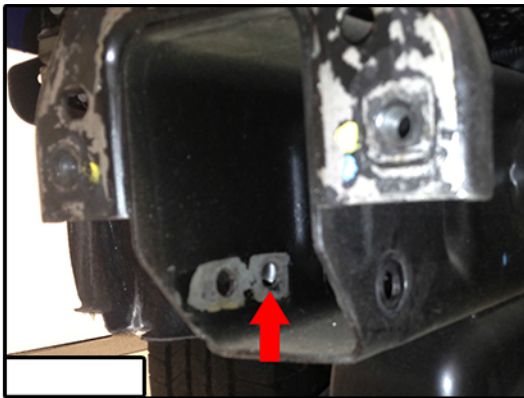
Recommended Tools:

- Ratchet
- 18mm Socket
- 18mm Wrench
- 1/2" Drill Bit
- Drill

Step 1: Remove the front bumper and retain all hardware. Note: There are upward facing bolts that can be easily accessed if the grille is removed.

Step 2: Remove the factory tow hook using 18mm wrench and 18mm socket. Retain all hardware from this step.

Step 3: Looking at the passenger side frame rail you will see that there are 3 holes that are used to hold the factory tow hooks. Using a 1/2" drill bit, you must drill the rear hole so that it is now straight through and showing on both sides of the frame rail.



Installation Instructions

Step 4: Remove the plastic caps that surround the tow hook from the front bumper. See image below.

Step 5: Re-install the front bumper and grille using the factory hardware.

Step 6: Slide the light bar into place through the tow hook openings and slide the tow hooks back into place. Fasten the tow hook using the factory hardware with the exception of the rear bolt on the passenger side. Use the supplied 5" x 1/2" bolt and nylon nut in the rear passenger bolt.

Step 7: This will conclude the installation.
